## Shaun Russell, General Manager Lifewater International

"We won't stop until every child has safe water." That is the mantra and motto of Lifewater International, a Christian non-profit organization headquartered in SLO. Lifewater focuses on improving the quality of life for the world's most vulnerable rural communities through water access, sanitation and hygiene interventions. Lifewater strives to create a sustained and leveraged impact through the application of community-driven and appropriate water supply, sanitation and hygiene activities. Lifewater has been involved with this critical mission for 40 years serving

over 2.5 million people in 45 countries.

Shaun Russell (*left*) has been General Manager of Lifewater for 3 years. Previously, he spent 12 years working in college athletics directing the marketing, corporate relations, and development departments at Cal Poly and the University of Maine. Shaun holds a degree in Business Administration from the University of Maine. He lives with his wife and children in Atascadero.

Shaun was joined during the presentation by Bobby deLancellotti (*right*). Bobby came to Lifewater in 2015 to build relationships with local churches. As a pastor for more than 30 years, he brings extensive ministry experience and passion to Lifewater's mission. Bobby is a graduate of Mater Dei High School, same as Prez Tony Wallace. Bobby spent extensive time in Zambia where he first learned of the global water and sanitation crisis.

The global statistics are grim: 1,600 children die *each day* from preventable water borne illnesses. The five part strategy for addressing this is rather simple: wash hands, use a latrine, store & use water safely, use a drying rack, and clean the living compounds of animal waste. Lifewater International served over 50,000 people last year and plans to double that to 100,000 this year and beyond. If you are looking for a charity to help a huge number of children, Lifewater is a great candidate!
